TERMITE FUMIGATION MEETING OCTOBER 22, 7:15PM

Please mark your calendars to attend a town hall meeting on Thursday, October 22, 7:15pm, Clubhouse #2, about termite fumigation/tenting. A representative from the termite extermination company will be available to discuss what tenting involves because residents and pets must vacate the premises for two (2) nights. This project is planned for spring 2016 and may require a special assessment in the amount of \$600.00.

Termite fumigation/tenting was last done in 1995. Then, homeowners passed a special assessment for \$500.00 with the option of paying in full or in quarterly installments.

This meeting is IMPORTANT for all homeowners to attend. A Korean translator will be present.
