Flu Season Is Coming

Time to prepare for both the seasonal flu and the new H1N1, (swine flu). The symptoms and severity of H1N1 infections are similar to seasonal flu. Most cases of H1N1 have been mild, but public health officials are preparing for more serious cases.

Influenza-like illness is defined as fever (>37.8°C or 100°F) with either cough or sore throat. It is spread person to person through coughing or sneezing of people who are infected. Other symptoms can include a runny or stuffy nose, body aches, headache, chills and fatigue. Diarrhea and vomiting have also been reported.

People in high risk groups include children and youth under 25, pregnant women, and individuals with underlying medical conditions.

Important precautions to follow:

- >Cover your mouth and nose with a tissue when you cough or sneeze, or cough into your sleeve.
- >Wash hands often with soap and warm water or use alcoholbased hand cleaners and sanitizers, especially after you cough or sneeze.
- >Avoid touching your nose, mouth, and eyes.
- >Avoid close contact with people who might be ill. Reduce time spent in crowded settings.
- >Stay HOME! Do not go to school or to work until you or your children are without fever for at least 24 hours.
