Valley Vista Services provide curbside bulky waste/e-waste pickup <u>FREE OF CHARGE</u> for the first twelve (12) items per year. Please note that hazardous substances and hazardous waste will NOT be picked up, nor will overly large items that take more than two (2) people to lift. Scheduling bulky item pickups with Valley Vista Services will keep our community looking clean and save the Association money. Please be reminded that the Association pays another company to haul away large items when they are blocking the trash enclosures or left without scheduling a pick up. This is wasted money!
