#### TRASH TALK

The trash enclosures are a constant problem. Bulky goods and trash continue to be left outside the bins. Valley Vista will not pick up our trash bins when there is stuff on the ground inside the enclosures. And, big boxes need to be broken down. To help alleviate this problem, the Board has contracted with a company to keep these areas clean. They will pick up all items left inside the enclosures and clean the areas weekly. This comes at a cost of almost \$12,000.00 per year beginning in December. A few lazy and careless homeowners are costing us all.

### EXTRA MONEY, FLEXIBLE HOURS

CHOA is seeking a homeowner to manage the clubhouse rentals. This entails making reservations, ensuring the rules are understood **before** this rental agreement is signed, and collecting the deposit and fee from the renter. After the rental, the clubhouse must be inspected to make sure that everything is left clean and locked. Any violations of the rules must be reported to the Community Manager, Dianna Campellone, *dianna@accellpm.com* and made clear to the renter that there could be a possible loss of the deposit. The manager must also retrieve the clubhouse keys after the rental and forward the rental fees to Accell. The salary is \$100.00 per month, and the position will begin on January 1, 2019. Please contact Accell or any Board member if you are interested and/or have questions. The Board will be conducting short interviews at the Meeting on November 29.
